IHA TEEN GUIDELINES

Note: These are not meant to be a hardship on anyone but are there so each teen can stay focused on the Lord throughout the week without distraction. *Each camper will need to sign their registration form which will be their agreement to follow these guidelines!*

Young ladies are asked to wear modest clothing, which include: high necklines, skirts that come just below the knee, and shirts with sleeves - tight fitting clothing is inappropriate. Capris, knee-length shorts, and jeans are acceptable for sports only.

Young men are to wear long pants (either jeans or dress pants) and shirts. Knee-length shorts are acceptable for sports only. No tank-tops or sleeveless shirts are permitted.

Do not bring: Music, computer, DVDs, fireworks, and other like entertainment

With the desire that each participant can deepen their heart relationship with Christ without the distraction of boy/girl relationships, such interpersonal relationships will not be encouraged nor permitted.

The use of cell phones, whether talking or texting, will not be permitted during service times. There will be opportunities when a call can be made if it is needed. Our encouragement is that the cell phone would not be in use for each teen.
